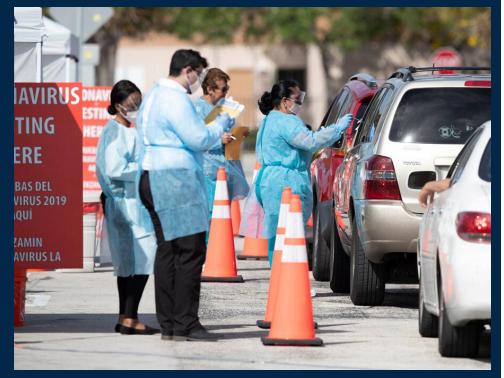


# I NEED A TEST FOR COVID-19
